About the Course

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

Pathways & Further Study

Upon successful completion of the Certificate III in Individual Support students will be offered advanced standing into the Certificate IV in Ageing Support. Students may also use the qualification to assist them in gaining entry level employment.

About the Course

This qualification reflects the role of support workers who complete specialised tasks and functions in aged services; either in residential, home or community based environments.

Workers will take responsibility for their own outputs within defined organisation guidelines and maintain quality service delivery through the development, facilitation and review of individualised service planning and delivery.

Workers may be required to demonstrate leadership and have limited responsibility for the organisation and the quantity and quality of outputs of others within limited parameters. This qualification provides skills and knowledge for an individual to work primarily in residential facilities and disability support centres under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisation guidelines and service plans.

Pathways & Further Study

The recommended pathway to this qualification is completion of CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support. Candidates may progress to higher level qualifications within and/or across the community sector.

After successful completion of the program, the student may gain employment in aged care services, disability support centre, residential group homes, training resource centres, day respite centres and open employment services, other community settings and clients' homes.
