About the Course

This is an exciting, creative and hands-on qualification reflecting the role of a skilled operator in the film, television, radio or digital media industries who applies a broad range of competencies in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement and relevant theoretical knowledge. They may provide technical advice and support to a team. This course is also offered full-time, part-time and to year 11 and 12 high school students.

Pathways & Further Study

Upon successful completion of the Certificate III in Media students may choose to continue their studies in the Diploma or Advanced Diploma of Screen & Media. Students may also use the qualification to assist them in gaining entry level employment including Archival media technician, Interactive media author assistant, Camera/Lighting assistant, Community radio program maker/presenter, Editing assistant, Production assistant.

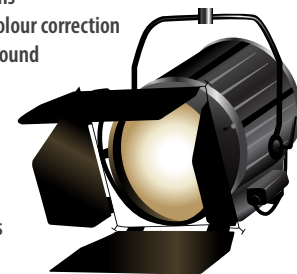
